## ARTIST BIOS

**JORY NASH:** Jory Nash is a 4-time Canadian Folk Music Award nominee and a Songs From The Heart Winner. He blends elements of folk, jazz, blues, soul and pop into an original stew of sound. He is the co-founder and current producer of THE WAY WE FEEL. Jory Nash has recorded 8 critically acclaimed CDs and begins work on his 9<sup>th</sup> in 2017. Jory plays guitar, piano and banjo and his warm voice and engaging stories urge you to listen. He collects hats and is a long suffering fan of the Toronto Maple Leafs.

**SUZIE UNGERLEIDER:** Born in Northeastern US and raised in Western Canada, Suzie Ungerleider began performing under the name Oh Susanna in the mid-1990s, winning instant praise for striking voice and poetic songcraft. For over two decades, thousands of shows, and ten critically acclaimed albums, Suzie's gloriously emotive, crystalline voice, her bewitching performances, her poignant story-telling and her fierce song-writing have consistently captivated audiences, her peers and the press. She is the recipient of a Genie Award for Best Original Song and a Canadian Folk Music Award for English Songwriter of the Year. She has been nominated for three Juno Awards and four Canadian Folk Music Awards for Best Solo Performer, Best Contemporary Singer, and English Songwriter of the Year. Suzie's latest album entitled My Name is Suzie Ungerleider is her first release under her given name and has recently been nominated for a Juno for Best Contemporary Roots Album of the Year. Suzie lives in Vancouver with her husband, her daughter and their dog Willow.

**MATTHEW BARBER:** Matthew Barber is a Toronto-based singer-songwriter who has been making records and touring Canada and beyond for two decades. Of his 11 albums, Ghost Notes (2008) and The Family Album (2016) - a collaboration with sister Jill Barber - are perhaps the most widely known and both received Juno nominations. In the last two years Matthew has turned his attention to producing albums for others, but he's also pleased to have brand new music of his own out in summer 2022 in the form of an E.P. entitled No Singing Or Dancing. Matthew's introduction to Gordon Lightfoot was through his mother's records that he absorbed at a young age. He has since had the great honour of playing some of these songs in front of the man himself at "The Way We Feel" tribute shows at Hugh's Room in Toronto.

**JASON FOWLER:** Toronto guitarist/singer/songwriter/producer Jason Fowler has released 6 independent solo albums since his debut in 1995. As a session guitarist he has played on over 100 albums, T.V. & radio spots, film soundtracks and in the live bands for the Toronto productions of *The Lion King* and *The Girl From The North Country*. He has performed and/or recorded with innumerable Canadian and international artists including Loreena McKennit, Michelle Wright, Valdy, Pavlo, Nana Mouskouri, The Irish Tenors, Susan Aglukark, Bruce Cockburn, Murray McLauchlan, Amy Sky, Marc Jordan, Heather Rankin, Alex Cuba, Quartette, Anne Lindsay, Suzie Vinnick, Justin Rutledge, and Madison Violet. Jason is acknowledged as one of Canada's most gifted guitarists. He holds an Honours Degree from McGill University in Classical Guitar Performance and is a two-time winner at the prestigious Walnut Valley National Guitar Championships. Jason has been guitarist and musical director for John McDermott since 2002. In the summer and fall of 2019 Jason played in the bands for the Toronto productions of *The Lion King* and *The Girl From The North Country*.
