

The Stockey Centre Alcohol Policy

The regulations of the Liquor License Act of Ontario will be strictly enforced at all times.

The Stockey Centre reserves the right to refuse service of alcoholic beverages to anyone attending an event at the Centre. If anyone under the legal drinking age, or anyone, who has been refused service, continues to consume alcoholic beverages, the bar will be closed immediately and the function terminated.

The Stockey Centre reserves the right to inform local police and other businesses of any intoxicated person who leaves the facility. All incidents will be recorded by Stockey Staff.

The Stockey Centre is responsible for the administration of the sale & service of all alcoholic beverages as governed by the liquor laws of Ontario. All liquor served during the event must be purchased under the Stockey Centre's liquor license at the price determined by the Manager. Under no circumstances may guests bring in any alcoholic beverages onto the property.

The safe consumption of alcohol is only permitted inside the facility and the back patio. All other areas such as the parking lots or the side of the building are not licensed and will be monitored during an event. Any consumption of alcohol on those areas may result in the bar closing.

The Stockey Centre does not allow any food or beverage to be brought into the Centre without prior consent from the Manager. No leftover beverages may be removed from the Centre.

As with any event, safety comes first. Guests are encouraged to arrange alternate transportation to and from the Centre if they choose to consume alcohol.

Alcohol can be served from 11am to 1am.

The Stockey Centre reserves the right to switch from glassware to plastic for safety reasons.

Additional Information:

- 1. No Smoking is permitted on property, including vaping and marijuana.
- Children must be supervised at all times
- 3. Guests can purchase up to TWO drinks at a time
- 4. No Shots or Doubles will be served at any time.
